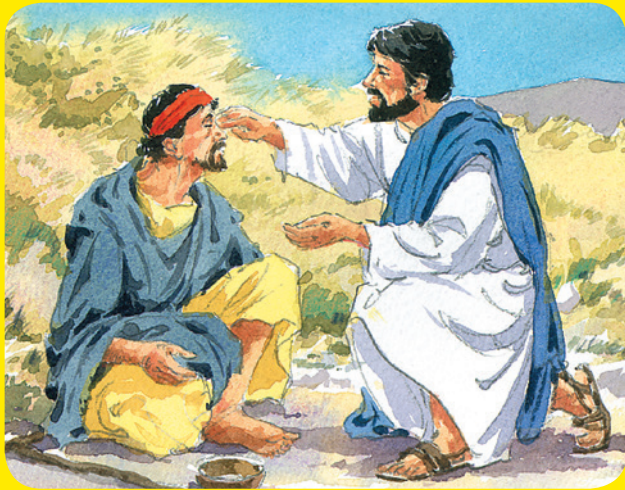


Jesus Helps a Man Believe in Him

Bible Story based on John 9:1-38; 20:31



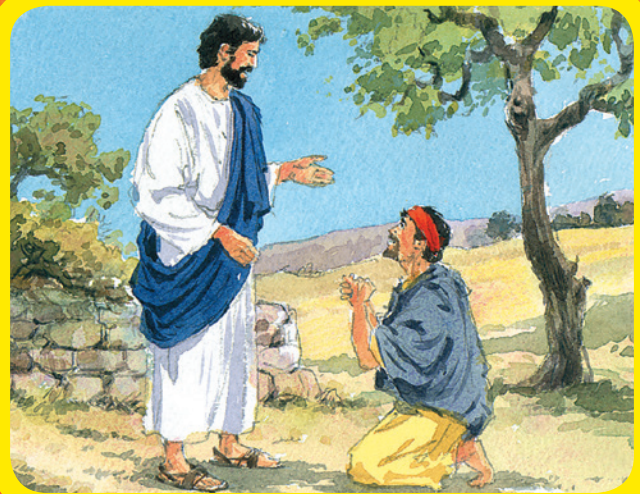
1. There was a man who was born blind. Jesus helped this man believe in God by healing his eyes. Jesus made some mud to put on the man's eyes.



2. Then Jesus said to the man, "Go to a pool of water and wash the mud off." The blind man listened to Jesus. He washed the mud off at a pool.

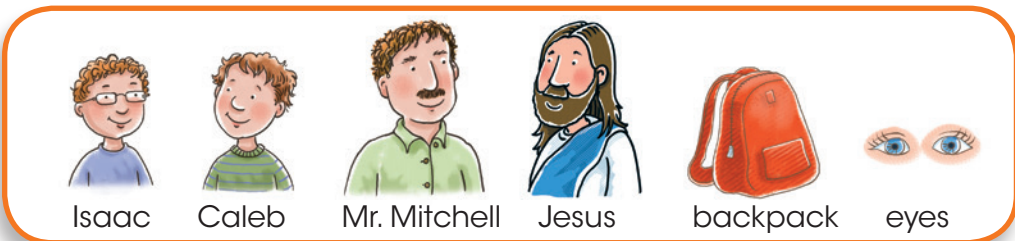


3. Suddenly, the man could see! He was so excited. He told everyone that a man named Jesus had made his eyes see.

Talk Time

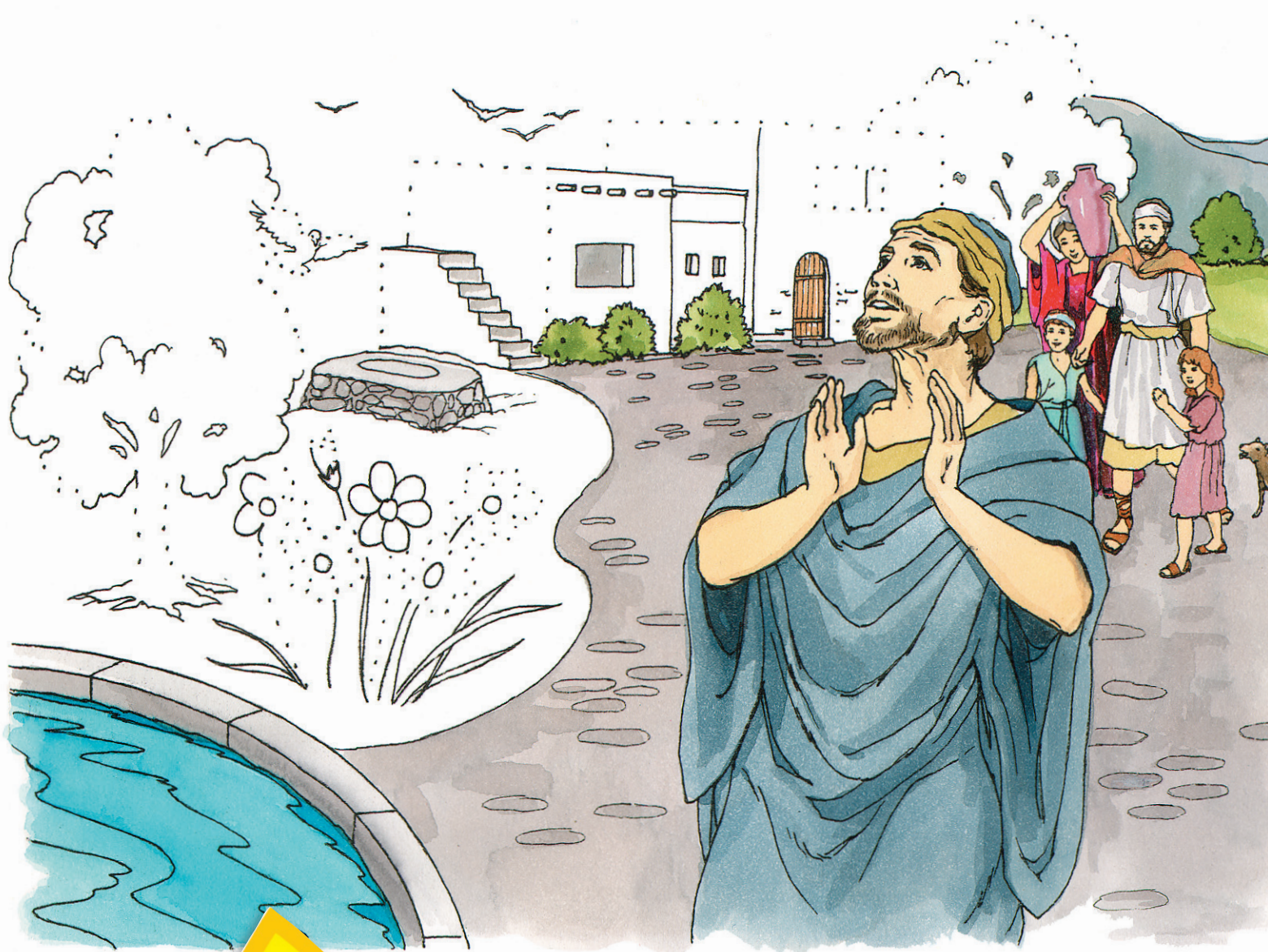
WHAT I LEARNED ABOUT JESUS:
